- 3) **AREA OF OPERATION:** State level
- 4) **AIMS & OBJECTIVES:** The aims & objectives for which the Society is established are:
- To work for **RURAL & URBAN** community in strengthening Oral health Care & Primary health care across India.
 - To promote oral health awareness, oral cancer awareness, tobacco cessation workshop, programs, lectures, seminars, conferences.
 - To make animated movies, short Movie, Documentary, thesis, dissertation, survey on Oral Health care, Primary Health care Facilities, Rural and Urban Life.
 - To set up affordable rural dental and medical clinics, diagnostic laboratories, pathological laboratories, X Ray units, Blood donation camps and other medical investigation plans in rural and urban areas.
 - To aid and support deserving socially weak or physically handicapped individuals in procuring durable, sophisticated and scientifically manufactured modern standards aid and appliances that promote their physical, social, emotional and psychological rehabilitation and also to provide support to the aged by opening old age home, day care centre, mobile/ fixed medical & dental services.
 - To improve quality, accessibility and affordability of health care in general (EYE, DENTAL, MENTAL, MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH) including all forms of alternative healing (not restricted to Yoga, Meditation, Reiki etc).

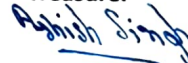

vii) To work for underprivileged section of society for their basic needs and living, to make sustainable project / model to end poverty in India. To reduce Malnutrition amongst the deprived section of the society.

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viii) Building Partnership with Government and Private sectors

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ix) To establish maintain and encourage self-help groups, cottage industries, khadi and village industries programs for the benefits of women, youth and marginalized groups. (Weaving, knitting and village industries programmes, agricultural, small and medium scale industry set up)

x) To undertake scientific research, thesis, dissertation, investigations and implement action oriented projects which would bring about direct and positive results in conserving the natural environment, reducing waste and its disposal, consuming less energy by using erosion methods ensuring optimum recycling of all resources, protecting habitats and areas to allow natural regeneration of plants etc. and to undertake research and action towards a broad agenda of conserving biodiversity including conserving natural resources, reducing waste and promoting recycling.



xi) To combat the menace of consumption of alcohol and drugs by creating awareness and educating people about that ill effects of alcohol and tobacco, drug abuse, and to evolve culture specific modes for prevention of drug abuse and treatment and rehabilitation of drug addicts including involvement in the control programs of HIV/AIDS crisis. To promote, educate, conduct mental and psychological program, clinics, seminars, lectures, de-addiction centres in urban and rural areas across India

xii) To work in co-operation with other local, national and international societies, institutions, organisations and any other group or individual in the pursuit of the aims and objects of the Society.

xiii) To set up access to safe and sustainable sanitation, personal hygiene, toilets for urban and rural areas.

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- xiv) To organise fund raising events, exhibition & shows (fashion shows, musical concerts, awareness programs, theatre plays, nukkad naatak, charity shows, marathons, and other community-engagement activities aimed at raising funds, spreading awareness, promoting social causes, and supporting the charitable objectives of the Foundation across health, education, environment, nutrition, mental well-being, and community development.
- xv) To undertake and promote various formal and non-formal educational activities and to run programmes for literacy awareness social, welfare development & cultural development. To build schools, vocational centres and to provide education to underprivileged children & disadvantaged section of the society.
- xvi) To conduct program, projects to eradicate child labour, child marriage, child trafficking, gender inequality, save the girl child in urban and rural areas.
- xvii) To conduct mass marriages irrespective of any caste, creed & culture.
- xviii) To publish books, pamphlets, Audio, Video, Picture, periodicals and newspaper, magazines in India or Outside to spread awareness in advancement of child & adult health, education, food, lifestyle & culture.
- xix) To support disaster survivors by means of rehabilitating them.
- xx) To promote, empower and build the vocational & technical training framework, skill up-gradation, building new skills and innovative thinking in young aspirants, minorities, women and rural/ urban population also covering the hilly areas, challenging locations.
- xxi) To support research & development through science & technology for empowering life, sustaining livelihoods at grass root level. To promote educational seminars, science exhibition, industry applied R&D, exhibition, workshop, Scholarship, Mega science & technology program, fellowship, virtual network centres, up-gradation program for young aspirants and urban/ rural village stakeholders. To Upgrade & empower technology & approach in schools, hills/ mountains area & disadvantaged section of the society, tribal etc.
- xxii) To promote youth to create productive workforce through education, entrepreneurship, employment, skill development. To incorporate social values, community engagement, civic engagement in youth. To develop strong & healthy generation, healthy lifestyle and personality through sports and other activities

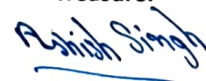

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xxiii) To promote social & economic empowerment of women through cross cutting policies & programmes, mainstreaming gender concerns, creating awareness about their rights & facilitating institutional & legislative support for enabling them realize their human rights and develop to their full potential. To ensure development, care & protection of children through cross cutting policies and programmes, spreading awareness about their rights and facilitating access to learning, nutrition, institutional and legislative support for enabling them to grow and develop to their full potential

xxiv) To enable Indian pharmaceutical industry to play leading role in global market and to ensure abundantly availability, at reasonable price within the country, of good quality pharmaceuticals of mass consumption

xxv) Without prejudice to the generality of the above aims and objects and for realization of the aims & objective of the society, the society shall have the power to acquire, receive, hold and dispose off property of any kind including cash donations, securities and negotiable instruments, by lease construct and maintain buildings and to have right to equipment them suitably, to manage transfer, mortgage pledge, sale and otherwise dispose off or deal with the property of the society in any manner what so ever to enter into contracts for and in connection with any of the purpose of the society, to raise loans, money and funds for and on behalf of the society and any other associated societies.

xxvi) To establish and implement comprehensive Diet & Nutrition Support Programs aimed at preventing malnutrition and promoting community health. This shall include providing individualized dietician plans, conducting nutrition-related assessments, organizing awareness workshops, school and community training sessions on healthy eating, hygiene practices, menstrual hygiene, maternal & child nutrition, lifestyle diseases, and overall wellness. The Foundation may collaborate with qualified dieticians, health experts, and institutions to deliver counselling, create educational resources, supply necessary nutritional support, and implement interventions for vulnerable groups including children, women, elderly, and underserved communities.

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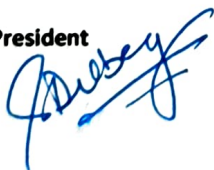
xxvii) To organize and facilitate preventive health screening services including blood testing, anaemia detection, oral and general cancer screening, tobacco-related disease assessment, and other diagnostic evaluations essential for early identification of health risks. The Foundation shall conduct community-based camps, awareness programs, counselling sessions, and follow-up guidance, and may collaborate with medical professionals, laboratories, hospitals, and health institutions to ensure accurate testing, reporting, and timely referrals for further treatment and care.

xxviii) To promote mental health awareness and emotional well-being through counselling sessions, stress-management programs, workshops on mindfulness, life skills, and resilience building. The Foundation shall work towards reducing stigma around mental health, provide support systems for individuals in distress, and collaborate with qualified psychologists, counsellors, therapists, mental health professionals, and mental health organizations to deliver accessible and community-oriented mental well-being initiatives

xxix) To promote Indian art, culture, and heritage, and to use art as a medium for community building and social development. The Society shall conduct workshops, festivals, performances, exhibitions, and educational programs across various art forms, and foster inclusion, emotional well-being, and awareness through creative engagement. It may also integrate innovative tools such as an AI Care Manager using NLP engines to support mental health, education, and community welfare initiatives. The Society may undertake training, mentorship, research, and empowerment programs, and collaborate with institutions, NGOs, CSR partners, and government bodies, functioning strictly as a not-profit.

All the income earnings, movable and immovable properties of the societies shall be solely utilised and applied towards the promotion of its aim and objects only set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no profit on there of shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present of past members of the society or any persons or past members. No member of society shall have Any personal claim on any moveable or unmovable properties of the society or make any profit, whatsoever by virtue of his/her/its membership.

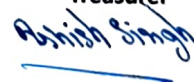

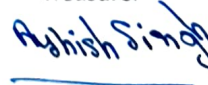

Delhi**RULES AND REGULATIONS****1. NAME OF THE SOCIETY HEALTHY AFFORDABLE SOLUTIONS NATIONALLY FOR AAM AADMI FOUNDATION (HASNAA)**

2. MEMBERSHIP: The membership of the society is open to any person who has attained the age of majority and fulfils the terms and conditions of the society but the subject to the approval of the governing body of the society.

Note: written application is must for membership, If the Governing body of the society does not approve the membership, then he/she should not be allowed to become the member of the society in any way.

3. ADMISSION FEE

The admission fee and the subscription shall be as under unless otherwise revised by the Governing body of the society Admission fee Rs. 1100/- (Twenty-One Hundred Only) at the time of Admission

4. TYPE OF MEMBERS

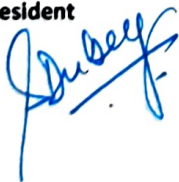
At present there in only one type of members namely, general members. Governing body of society will decide different types of members in its meeting called for this purpose. Main subscription and voting powers of such members shall also be in some meeting.

5. TERMINATION OR CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The governing body of the society shall have the powers to expert/terminate a Member of and Members, from the membership of the above society on the following grounds.

- a) On death
- b) On written Resignation
- c) If found to be involved in any Anti-social activities
- d) If adjudged by any court of law to be a Criminal offender.
- e) If found guilty by means of anti-propaganda of the aims and objects of the society
- f) If fails to pay the subscription of contribution for the three times.
- g) If has not attended three consecutive meetings.

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- h) If disregards Rules and Regulations or disobey the decision of the Governing Body
- i) If the Governing body feels that the Member is not appropriate so the society and Majority of Governing Members want to cancel his/her membership.

Note: The decision of the governing body regarding the termination from the Membership of the society shall be communicated to the member concerned.

6 GENERAL BODY DEFINED:

All the members of the society will constitute the general body of the society.

7 FOUNDER MEMBERS

Members of first Governing body/ executive committee shall be known as founder members of the society

8 PATRON OF THE SOCIETY

Governing body has right to appoint any distinguished/ eminent person as the patron (s) of the society from time to time.

9 GENERAL BODY:

a) Notice: minimum "15" day notice shall be given to the member, before the date of general body meetings specifying date time, place and issues to be discussed (Notice can convey by post/phone/email)

b) Meeting: General Body meeting shall be held once in every year.

c) Quorum: The quorum of general body meetings shall be 1/34 (one third) of the general body members of the society.

10. RIGHT & PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS

All and every member of the society:

a) Shall be entitled to participate in meeting cultural/educational functions and other lawful gatherings called/arranged by the society.

b) Have right to collect the Receipt after depositing the required/prescribed membership fee fixed by the governing body of the society from time to time.

11 DUTIES OF THE MEMBERS:

All and every member of the society shall:

- a) Elect the governing body of the society.
- b) Attend the general body meeting regularly
- c) Give the necessary information to the society, pertaining to any manner, which is necessary to be known by the society.
- d) Not indulge in activities, which are prejudicial to the aims and objects and/or the rules & regulations of the society.
- e) Any General Member cannot use the name, Letter Pad, Stamp etc. of the society, without written permission of the President or the Secretary of the Society.

12 GOVERNING BODY

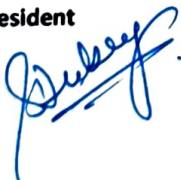
- a) **STRENGTH:** The strength of governing body including office bearers shall not be less than 9 and not more than 21.
- b) **Notice:** minimum 10 days' notice shall be required for every governing body meeting of the society but urgent meetings can be called by 24 hours notice. Notice can convey by post/phone/email)
- c) **Term:** Term of every governing body shall be Five Years
- d) **QUORUM:** Quorum of every governing body meeting shall be (half of the total strength of the governing body (including office bearers and executive member)
- e) **MEETING:** Governing body meeting may be held once in every quarter (or as and when the governing body of the society may decide from time to time)

13 FUNCTIONS & POWERS OF GOVERNING BODY:

Governing body shall be responsible for the management and administration of all affairs of the society and is also authorized to appoint any office bearer/executive member to look after any particular activity. Governing Body shall have also the following powers:

- a) To take necessary steps for the implementation of all the programs and policies drawn by the general body.
- b) To pass the necessary expenditure to meet the day-to-day requirement of the society
- c) To take decisions on application for new Membership
- d) To prepare plans, project and programs.
- e) To manage the affairs of the society and kept to keep control over the property of the society and all its assets.
- f) To invest the funds of the society not immediately required in such a manner as may be determined by the Governing Body.

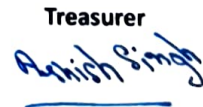

- g) To send representative (s) to any authority, Organization, " Department, Exhibition or contests and trainings etc. within or outside India.
- h) To appoint the patron (s) of the society
- i) The executive committee can arrange the loans up to Rs 10 lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) from any Bank or Financial Institutions and if more than Rs 10 lakh is required approval of general body is compulsory.
- j) To arrange and receive the loan from any Bank (s) or from any other legal entity or individual on reasonable terms and conditions, the governing Body as a whole shall be liable for its return.
- k) To accept donations, grants, gifts, contributions, subscriptions and endowments also to donate to any Organisation/Individual/Society etc.
- l) To establish and collect found and accept donations n cash or in kind and to Utilize the same and the income they are from for the purpose of society.
- m) To receive money, securities, instruments and or any other movable property for and on behalf of society.
- n) To render into agreement for and on behalf of society
- o) To take all such other legal steps which may appear beneficial for smooth/better management of society

In case of any dispute or arbitration, decision of Patron is final.

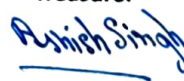

PRESIDENT

President shall be the subject to control and supervision of Governing Body. Have the power to make general directions and management of the affairs relating to the society.

The president of the society shall also enjoy the following powers and duties:

- a) President shall summon and preside over meetings of society.
- b) President shall have the power to call any urgent meeting by short notice.
- c) At the time of voting on any matter/subject (except election), if the total votes of the group of members happen to be equal in number the President has to cast an extra vote to decide the matter/subject.
- d) In the event of any office bearer(s) seat falling vacant the power and functions of the office bearer/executive member would vest in the President.
- e) President will get the account of the society audited by the qualified auditor, appointed by the governing Body of the Society.
- f) President may sign the papers/letter certificate on behalf of the society, to conduct its correspondences.
- g) President should appear before any Court of Law/legal Department/organisation etc. on behalf of the society.
- h) To appoint/terminate such staff as may be required for effective & efficient management of the affairs of the society and fix their remuneration.
- i) President has the power to may represent the society in any Department/Organisation etc. on behalf of the society.
- j) President can take decision on any urgent issue/ matter if there is no time to call meeting. But it should be discussed in meeting as soon as possible.
- k) All decision having Financial Implication shall be taken by the President, Bank account shall be operated under the signature of President Only.

SECRETARY

- a) Secretary may summon for the meeting of Society and decide the Agenda of the meeting shall circulate the notice to the concerned EAS office Bearers and executive Member/General member

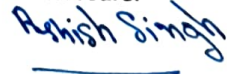

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- b) Secretary will prepare the membership Register as well as the proceeding register to record the minutes of proceeding of the governing body meeting and the general Body Meeting and have them duly signed by the members who attend the meetings
- c) Secretary may sign the papers/letter certificate on behalf of the society to conduct its correspondence
- d) To appoint/terminate such staff as may be required for effective & efficient management of the affairs of the society, and fix their remuneration.
- e) Secretary has the power to issue any Press Release, notification information on behalf of the society.
- f) Secretary may be treated as the Spokesperson of the society.

TREASURER

- a) All funds of society shall remain the care and management of Treasurer of the society.
- b) Treasurer shall maintain the accounts of all money, which is received and/or paid by him/her on behalf of the society.

EXECUTIVE MEMBERS

- a) Executive members are the important part of the governing Body.
- b) Executive members are supposed to attend all the Governing Body Meetings and also the General Body Meeting of the Society.

RE-ADMISSION

In case any member of the society is expelled by the governing body on the reason of non-payment of the subscription he can be re-admitted, provided the member concerned pays all up to date dues with the permission of the governing body.

17 APPEALS:

All the appeals shall be preferred to the Governing Body of the Society and the decision of the governing body shall be final.

18 FILLING UP OF CASUAL VACANCIES

Any casual vacancy amongst the Governing body shall be filled by the Resolution passed the Governing Body.

The Governing body is authorized to appoint/nominate any time Advisory Board to solve any matter/issues. The governing Body of the society can nominate any office bearer/executive member at the Chairman of this Kind of Advisory Board.

23 BANK ACCOUNT & OPERATION

The funds of the society shall be kept in any Nationalized Bank selected by Governing Body. The president and any one of the General Secretary Treasurer shall operate the bank account of the society.

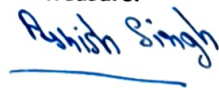

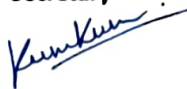
